INTRODUCTION

The Bachelor of Library and Information Science (B.Lib.I.Sc.) is an undergraduate program offered by Mangalayatan University (MUDE) through online distance learning mode. The programme curriculum is designed to build students' savoir-faire for social competence and knowledge in the field of library management, indexing, and documentation techniques. The core focus of the programme is to prepare learners to effectively manage libraries and information centers in educational institutions, corporate organizations, and research institutions.

The online distance programme aims to instruct them to develop an understanding of modern principles and practices of library science to guide them in learning both traditional and digital classification.
